Rick Sands did some field STATS on use and space of areas and fields for games and practices-trying to project into 2011 and 2012, # travel teams, field size, lights at fields, PLANNING—maybe partner with AU to use fields, check again with LaSalle? Field by Alvethorpe? Use our contacts for info. Practice fields also needed.

**TREASURER:** Sandy reports Operating acct \$52,989.54, Capital Acct \$6981.88, Gary Donnelly bill of \$7300 to be pd, \$250 brick ordered, Taxes are done and to sent in next week, copies of any responses are being kept for our records, THANKS Rich and Sandy!! Sandy has Insurance policies that are to stay at the clubhouse

REGISTRAR: Bob reports no changes from last report, starting to think of next year, need some committee cost numbers to budget, fee increase?? To cont discussion at Exec Meeting 1/15/11

FIELDS: John reports we need to build up relationships with other local clubs and this will help with our field problems, Can Ab township do more for us for the fields, John's goals are 1) establish contact with decision makers from Ab P & Rec, Ab Township and Chelt Township, 2) contact and meeting with Josh Shapiro's office in ref to SPS field space and plans, 3) contact field coordinators at local clubs for sharing field use, esp Cheltenham, 4) Explore ideas for additional fields with membership in club, 5) Develop plan so all travel teams can have 2 night/wk practice in fall—John discussed indoor availability-see him for gym use

EQUIPMENT: TIM reports there are 2 new 300' tapes in clubhouse, Hank is providing a breakdown of all our expenses for the last few years, this will help determine out budget needs, need to keep track of all purchases and expenses for the future. Tim has summary of field we use and sketches –SPS-this is too small except for pee wee, the field against Kenmore, sm 8x8 could be forced into the space between Kenmore and the baseball field, fence would need to be moved to get decent field to fit, also a hole in center of field, the field at the SW end by Woodlawn, could be a nice 8x8 field, but a tree and pump need to be taken care of—AJHS fields 6 & 7-maybe fit 3 sm 8x8 fields instead of 2 sm 11 x 11? AJHS Band field-an 8 x 8 could fit, it would help distribute the parking, but there are bare patches, steep slope at one end and not close to another similar size fields McKinley Ele-maybe 3 8 x 8 fields, Parking looks good, maybe 2 11 x 11 on the site if we moved 1 of the permanent goals right behind the school and finally Penbryn Master plan Study-Land Concepts is doing the study, they have our files, Doug W appreciates our help-

COACH AND PLAYER DEVELOPMENT: Moses reports some coaches are asking for the next training session which will take place in early spring
