COMMUNICATION AND CORRESPONDENCE: The process to obtain grants from the state has changed, there is \$6000 charge for this paperwork, We were in compliance, approved and need to file better and be more careful in the future-Sandy is working on the application process for insurance coverage and bonds. TREASURER: Bert reports Operating acct \$43,716.77 and Capital acct \$6,925.75—about \$6000 in bills paid tonight, all bills and refunds are out

REGISTRAR: Bob reports we are down about 100 players but this month is usually slow-New signs going out this week about registration, next in-person registration is 6/12/10 at the clubhouse, after that late fees are charged. Bob D reports our tax forms were filed but need to be modified. The firm that completed our state audit will do this at cost. We **MUST** find an accountant to keep our books, if we are to receive large grants in the future our financial reporting must be done more professional and organized. Bob received a suggestion we purchase QuickBooks software and use it for our check writing and spending. The software will have categories and can produce reports that will show our spending patterns and moving forward we can develop a budget from that.

SOCCER CAMP: Ed reports our numbers are down; Ed discussed the parents' thoughts that players get **BETTER** training playing travel?? Also to continue this discussion—Housing for 2 coaches needed the weeks of 7/5 and 7/12-let ED know. Bob Daniele said he is getting requests about "fall day camp"-can't be

done-another e-mail blast will go out this week for the camp-Ed said some heartfelt words about his friend Andy McDermott-again out condolences to the family.

COACH AND PLAYER DEVELOPMENT: Moses reports he will get together with Bob D for his thoughts on U7 training

STRATEGIC PLANNING: Tim Boles reports any applications for grants for the upper field are on HOLD due to the economy.

FUND RAISING: Sandy reports the brick order goes in this month and it takes 6 weeks to receive order, cost is about \$4500.00 from Capital Fund. Sandy will pick up coupons from Modells Sporting Goods for discounts and we will be able to print these out on the web site-\$4500 is cost of bricks to be paid from the capital fund

FIELDS: the field next to SPS being graded, will be a travel soccer field for Abington Township, check with Randy for all permits
