

MINUTES OF HUNTER SOCCER MEETING
HELD SEPTEMBER 3, 2009

CALLED TO ORDER: Meeting called to order at 8:11pm, at the Hunter Soccer Club House

MINUTES: Minutes moved, seconded, voted and approved.

COMMUNICATIONS AND CORRESPONDENCE: Need ALL coaches to volunteer to represent the Club at the ICSL at VE-Roll call is done at the beginning and the end of each meeting when our representative must be present. Also we want each of our travel teams to be represented at our HSC monthly meeting, that are held the first Thursday of each month except January and July, to learn and be kept informed of Club activities. Ralph did roll call for travel teams.

We received 2 thank you notes from recipients of the Sharon Klein Memorial Scholarship, Nick White and Dana Krimker—we wish them luck as they begin their college years. Our former Vice-President, Dan Cowhey gave a donation in the Club's name to United Way in the amount of \$1,214.90—thanks to Dan and Donna for that!! Bob Daniele mentioned Magnum Inc Cert of Liability Insurance copy will be given to Regina to hold with the Minutes-Bob to get copy to Regina.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Executive meeting held at the HSClubhouse on 6/22/09—some complaints discussed were some Hunter teams going indoor to local tournaments and parents weren't aware of try-outs for this, etc. This is why "the CLUB" selects the young travel teams, to avoid these types of issues. A coach meeting was held 9/1/09 as a forum to get information, answer questions and understand reasons some of the club rules are in place. **ROLL CALL** at the monthly meeting now for the purpose of distributing referee fees monthly, keeping everyone informed and updated on club and league information and to get feed back from the coaches and families. **WEARING THE HUNTER HOOPS**—must wear in all league games unless there is a conflict. **PRACTICE TIMES**—see randy for field use.

VICE-PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Thad working on getting an official QPR flag for the clubhouse (QUEENS PARK RANGERS Soccer team from England who taught at the Hunter camps when the club was first started and whose hopped blue and white uniform we still wear) —\$\$ approved for this. Also Thad working on more grants for field improvements, one being through the US Soccer Foundation. \$\$ available for lights, grass, etc. Thad spoke to Meadowbrook facility manager—they have 2 fields, 1 field for 8x8. May use for U-11. Games would need to be in afternoon—\$50 fee/week—maybe use for Sunday 8x8 with 9am start—Chris will check with EPYSA for this. Discussion about Roychester followed.

TREASURER: Bert and Sandy-all bills paid. \$27,000 to Hank for uniforms, Operating Acct \$50,262.84 and Capital Acct \$18,299.77 with one more payment due to Magnum Inc for Clubhouse. Referee checks to be distributed after the meeting. If any \$\$ left over for the ref fees, please return to Bert-thanks.

SECRETARY: Regina asking for list of volunteers to be called for JWT, Bob W had list, also list of Travel coaches to be called to come to monthly meetings, Chris had list – Mike Dunn suggested we send minutes on-line if possible-Regina to e-mail minutes to Chris for review then Chris can send e-mail.

REGISTRATION: Bob W has shut this down for the season, about 1078 kids total without the juniors counted. Need all names for our data base- Bob had \$5000 in checks for Bert. Registration income about \$112,000 for now, option to donate took in just under \$2100-thanks to all!! Regina to send thank you notes for donations when I get the list-or send a thank you via e-mail. Bob gave tax-ID info to Ralph, Regina to hold with the minutes for now

EQUIPMENT : Mike Brown cleaned equip room-if anyone needs anything, let Mike know-Please everyone help keep this area clean and organized.

FIELDS: Randy has packet for permits, Bob D waiting on ok for the 2 Cheltenham fields. John Steinberg doing the indoors-Thad reminds all to have permits and player cards esp. for each home game.

COACH AND PLAYER DEVELOPMENT: Moses has scheduled 9/12/09 a soccer intramural class for coaches 1pm to 3pm at Pen Bryn field

SOCCER CAMP: No report.

JACK WALSH TOURNAMENT: Bert reports about 127 teams so far. 3 Hunter teams not registered yet. Volunteers needed, coaches ask your parents to get involved. About 20 fields-need help with registration Friday evening 5:30pm to 9pm and Saturday morning 6:30 am to noon and noon to 4pm-also need help lining the fields Friday morning at 9am-meeting at Abington Jr., need field marshals and clean-up crew as well as fund raising volunteers-can contact Regina Bocchino at RegB6@aol.com, ALL TEAMS will check in at the clubhouse starting Friday evening at 6pm and Sat morning at 7am. A PINK CARD will be given to the coaches that means they registered their team. Jackie Kershaw won the design contest for the T-shirt (Hank to do these) CONGRATS JACKIE!! , new T-shirt vendor on site to give 15% of intake to Club. Each team to get a BAG with maps, instructions, contact info, coupons (obtained by MRS CINDY GRAUL) book, etc.—9/9/09 will be a JWT meeting at the clubhouse. Take note of the RULES, esp. tie-breaker rules. We partnered with Demisphere for on-line tournament registration that has been awesome. There will be some concession stands at the smaller sites this year. Chris reports all scoring will be on-line this year, needs scores of each game, will still have boards at the field.
